
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together. Before each page turn, predict what will happen next in the story.
 - An author writes a story and an illustrator does the artwork book. Determine which character is the author, and which character is the illustrator.
- More Difficult: Locate the letters Dd and Pp on the front cover. Talk about the sound they make. Listen for and locate those two sounds as you read the story together again.
- Challenging: Verbs are action words.

 As you read the story together, locate at least one action word on each page.
