
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Look at the front cover. Point to the <u>J</u> in Just and the <u>P</u> in Playing. As you read the story together, find the letters Jj and Pp in the story.
- More Difficult: Some words are used more than others. Example—and, the, a, my, be, I, to. As you read the story together, point to these high frequency words and have your child "read" them.
- Challenging: There are many different types of workers in the book. Examples—architect, scientist, fire fighter. Discuss what each of these people do at their job.
