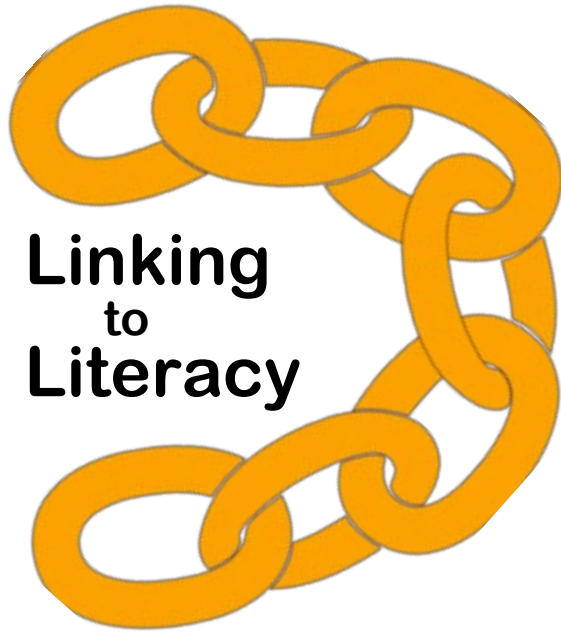


Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



Linking to Literacy

- **Easiest:** Look at the **front cover**. Point to the **J** in **Just** and the **P** in **Playing**. As you read the story together, **find the letters Jj and Pp** in the story.
- **More Difficult:** Some words are used more than others. Example—**and, the, a, my, be, I, to**. As you read the story together, point to these **high frequency words** and have your child “read” them.
- **Challenging:** There are many different **types of workers** in the book. Examples—**architect, scientist, fire fighter**. **Discuss** what each of these people do at their job.
