
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together. The word "chicken" begins with the letter Cc. Have your child point to the letter C on each page and count them.
- More Difficult: Adding the letter Hh to s, t, and c changes the sound they make. Find words in the story that have the digraphs sh, th, and ch.
- Challenging: Help your child expand their vocabulary by researching chickens.
 Make a list of the various parts of a chicken, such as wing, beak, etc.
