
Simple activities designed to help parents and/or caregivers participate in, and support, a child's literacy skills and educational goals:



- Easiest: Read the story together. Point out the capital T's in the title, A Truck Named Tony. Read the story again to find capital T's as well as discover lowercase t's.
- More Difficult: Notice the punctuation, or "stop signs" at the end of each sentence. Decide if it is a question mark, period, or exclamation mark.
- Challenging: Verbs are words that show action. On each page, locate and list action verbs.
